

RoofGard in action...

(Examples of the main processes, some of which may not apply to all installations.)

STAGE 01

Inspection

Before the RoofGard coating is applied, the contractor is required to inspect the roof in question and then perform all the necessary preparation work in accordance with Andura recommendations.

STAGE 02

Restoration

This may include: repairs, replacement of damaged tiles, removal of moss & lichen and general cleaning down.

STAGE 03 Biocide Treatment

It is recommended surfaces are treated with Andura Biocide to protect from future growth of moss and lichens.

STAGE 04

Application

Application of RoofGard can then be carried out with a two coat process, in order to provide the tiles with full protection from weathering, giving you the appearance of a new roof.
